“Men Leading Interprofessional Practice: We’re All in This Together”

The American Assembly for Men in Nursing is accepting submissions for oral and poster presentations for its annual conference. AAMN is seeking submissions from a variety of disciplines as well as nursing to present in Minneapolis, MN.

Submissions should address one or more of the following conference objectives:

1. Describe the benefits of interprofessional practice team approaches for patients and professional care providers
2. Explain the role of interprofessional practice basics and continuing education in facilitating care providers’ development of fully interprofessional clinical practice
3. Describe interprofessional practice opportunities for men as healthcare practitioners and their employing organizations
4. Discuss interprofessional education (IPE) and its implementation into nursing education.
5. Explore the role for diversity and contributions of diversity in the interprofessional team

Required Format:

Poster/Oral Presentation

1. Title
2. Problem or Research Question
3. Theoretical Framework
4. Methods/Design
5. Findings

Panel/Round Table Discussion

1. Title
2. Key Concepts
3. Synopsis
4. Conclusion

The required length of the abstract is 250-500 words submitted on a one-page, single-spaced typed page, 8.5 x 11” paper with a one-inch margin on all sides, and must include at least one objective it’s related to. Submissions must include a cover sheet with the title of the abstract, name(s) of author(s), address, and contact telephone number and e-mail address. Do not include bibliographies or articles with the submission. Please indicate your preference for an Oral or Poster presentation, Panel/Round Table at the top of the response. All abstracts are subject to a blind review process and candidates will be notified by email whether they have been accepted or not to present in Minneapolis. With acceptance each presenter will be required to complete paperwork for continuing education credits, which will be forwarded to you. Presenters are required to register and pay conference fees.
